## History

Five CAED conferences have been organized starting from Helsinki in 1996, and continuing in Bergamo (IT), the Hague (NL), Aarhus (DK) and London (UK).

The material of the conferences are published in books and as articles in a number of journals. The system has been pushed forward both national and international research projects and networks. Finland has been one of the leading countries.

## New period from 2005

The establishment of the CAED network with the aims:

- Bring together a broad program of research using micro data in a more structured way
- Create a global network of researchers that could facilitate new research opportunities for international comparisons
- Attract additional researchers from countries and fields who have not previously participated in the CAED conferences.
